

As we approach the peak season for winter visitors to our beautiful beaches. I want to remind our members of the additional hazards to the roads of Sarasota/ Manatee Counties.

Pre-Pandemic, 2019 the average visitors numbers for both counties was near 1.2 million visitors. The concept for the Blue Knights originated in a restaurant in Brewer, Maine called the "White Elephant". In the early morning on Friday and Saturday nights, local law enforcement would meet there before ending their shifts. Many rode their motorcycles on their time off and several of them decided to create a club. Eddie Gallant, Mike Hall, Bill Robinson, and Doug Miner were four of them.

Eddie Gallant (Bangor PD) was on our law enforcement softball team. He did not drink so on all of our road trips he was the designated driver. Bill Robinson (Maine State Police) was a practical joker, always looking for a way to pull a prank. Mike Hall (Brewer PD) was a ladies' man and was always there when you needed help. Doug Miner (Maine Warden Service) was the quite one. I knew Chuck Shuman (Brewer PD), Joel Rudman, Wayne Labree and Chuck Gisler but not as close.

When they formed the Blue Knights their intent was to allow all law enforcement agencies to bond in brotherhood and sisterhood through riding on motorcycles. Rank, departments or politics were not factors.

Unfortunately, it seems that over the years, some, have forgotten the real purpose of the Blue Knights. It's not about position, status, or power. It's about Cops taking care of Cops and helping those in need.


