

You can pray using words and thoughts from Scripture, here are some prayers that related to our profession as law enforcement officers, current and retired. How we can pray for a better outlook facing our nation.



- 1. Pray that God would open the hearts of law enforcement officers who are far from Him and draw them to Himself. Acts 16:14 •
- 2. Suicide is rampant among law enforcement—in fact, these men and women are at higher risk of taking their own lives than people in any other profession. Pray that officers who are facing hopelessness would discover the hope of Jesus Christ. Psalm 40:1-3 •
- 3. The rate of post-traumatic stress disorder and depression is five times higher among law enforcement than it is in the general population. These individuals regularly witness devastating violence. Ask God to heal their hearts along with those who work and live with them. 2 Thessalonians 3:3 •
- The number of police recruits continues to drop. Pray that the Lord would call young men and women who know Him, love Him, and follow Him to serve their communities in law enforcement. Ephesians 4:1-3 •
- 5. Pray for law enforcement leaders in departments all over our nation. Ask God to give them wisdom, strength, and guidance as they serve. 1 Chronicles 22:12 •
- 6. In recent years, police training programs have adapted to include new topics like de-escalation, mental illness, and crowd control. Please pray for both new and seasoned officers as they learn how to best serve our communities. Psalm 21:11; 1 Kings 3:9 •
- 7. While studies indicate that nearly 25% of police officers have experienced symptoms of depression, anxiety, or PTSD, only a fraction of them will ever seek help. Many say they are too embarrassed to ask. Please pray that God would help law enforcement leaders create a supportive work environment for officers. Colossians 3:1



LABOR DAY FACTS

- 1. The first U.S. Labor Day was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882 in New York City, planned by the Central Labor Union. The Labor Day parade of about 10,000 workers took unpaid leave and marched from City Hall past Union Square uptown to 42nd street, and ended in Wendel's Elm Park at 92nd Street and 9th Avenue for a concert, speeches, and a picnic.
- 2. Oregon was the first to declare Labor Day an official holiday in 1887.
- 3. Labor Day is considered the 'unofficial NFL season kickoff.' 99.44 percent of the time, the NFL plays its first official season game the Thursday after Labor Day.
- 4. The first Waffle house opened on Labor Day. In 1955, in Avondale Estates, GA, the very first Waffle House opened its doors to the public.
- 5. What are we celebrating? The contributions and achievements of the 155 million men and women who are in the U.S. workforce.
- 6. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in the District of Columbia and the territories.
